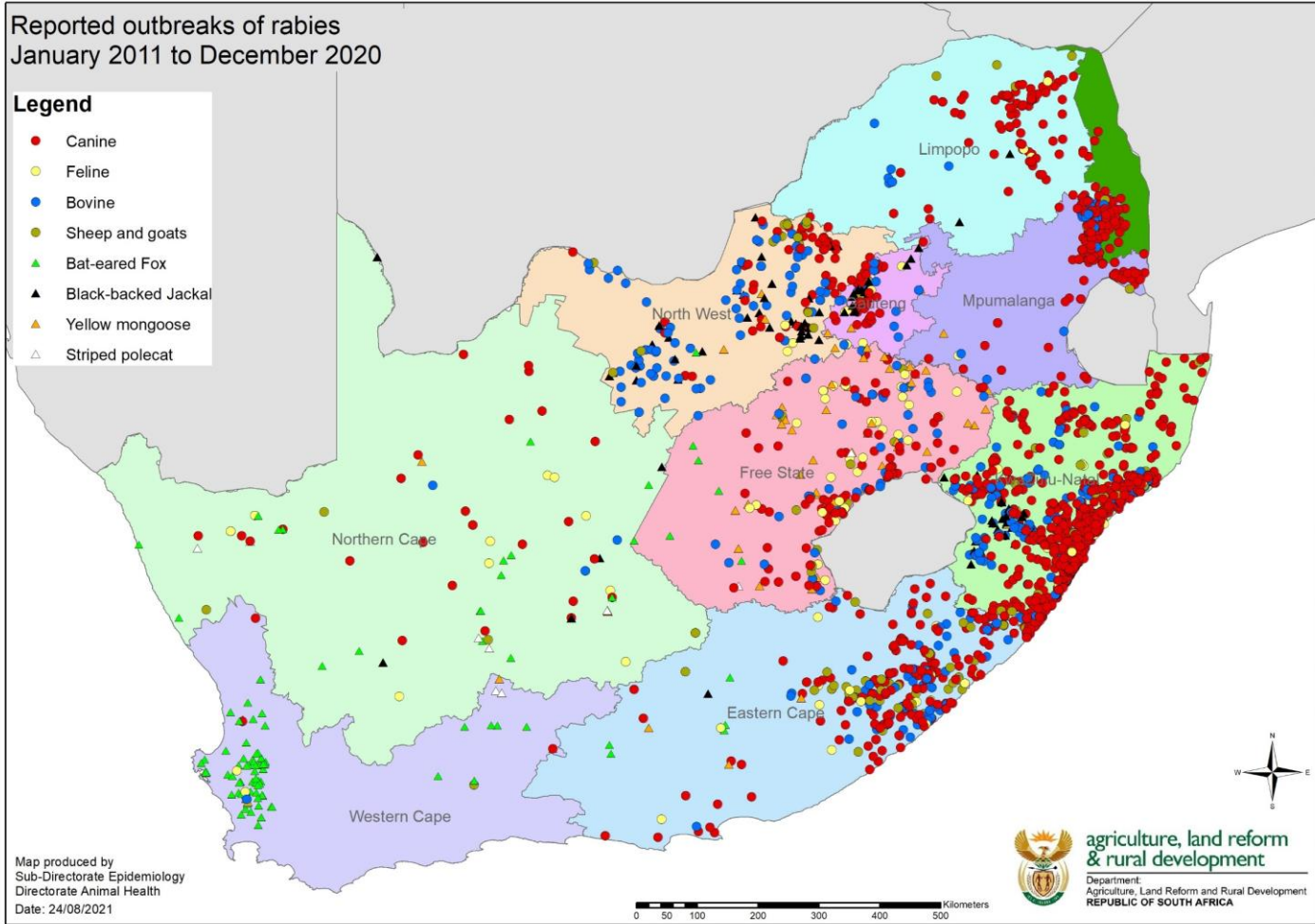

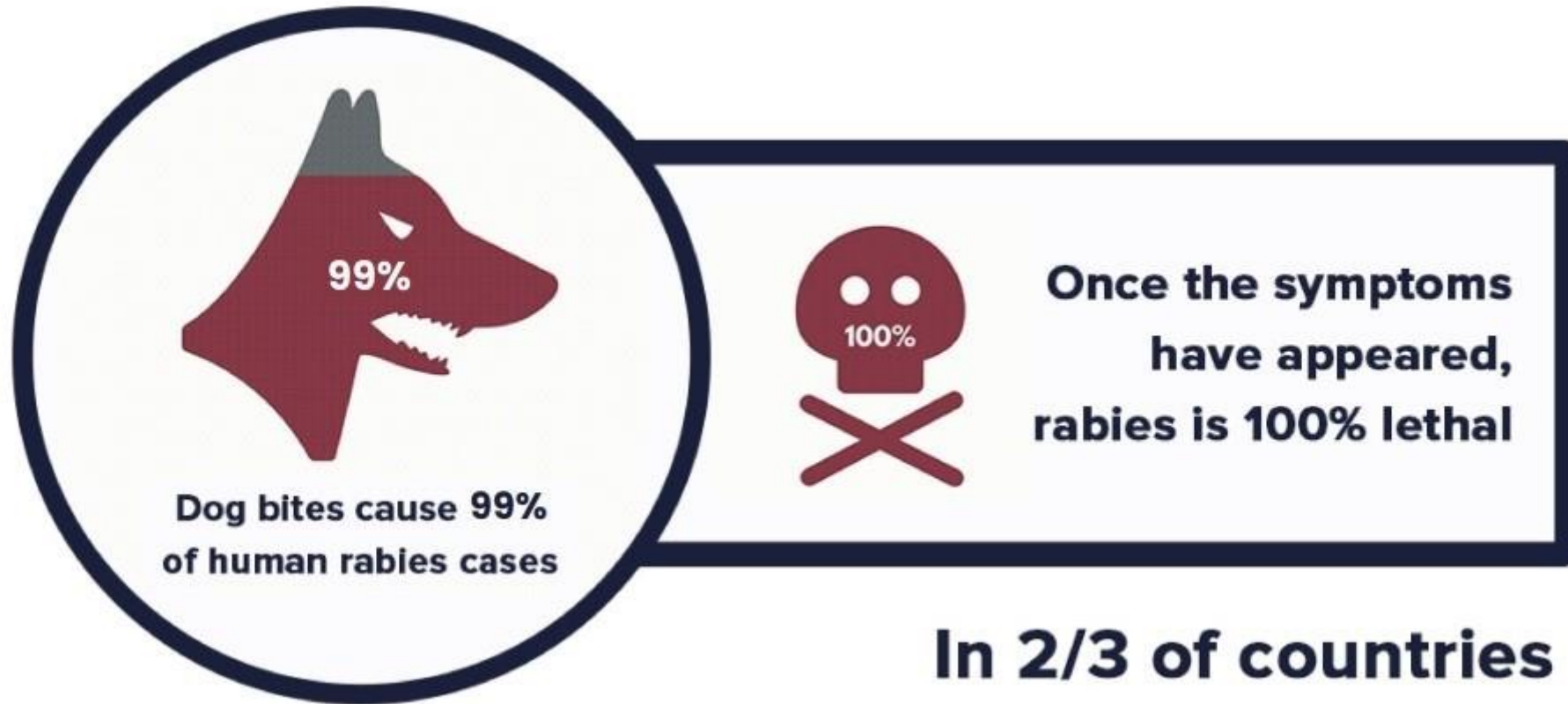

MYTHS	FACTS
RABIES IS NOT PREVENTABLE	RABIES IS PREVENTABLE
THERE IS NO TREATMENT FOR RABIES	THERE IS TREATMENT FOR RABIES, BUT IT MUST BE GIVEN CORRECTLY AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER EXPOSURE TO A RABID ANIMAL
RABIES IS ONLY TRANSMITTED BY DOG BITES	RABIES CAN BE TRANSMITTED BY THE BITE OF ANY INFECTED MAMMAL, BUT MOST COMMONLY BY DOG BITES
