RE: MOVEMENT OF LIVE ANIMALS ACROSS THE PORTS OF ENTRY/ EXIT

- 1. The abovementioned subject bears reference;
- Whilst facilitating legitimate movement of goods, including live animals, across the borders
 of the Republic it is important to ensure their safety and provide for their welfare
 considerations.
- 3. Means/ method of transportation have to be in such a manner that they are comfortable for travel.
- 4. The importer/ exporter remains responsible for their animal's feeding and watering needs, provided that it is according to local regulations.
- 5. It is also important to prioritise the animals' legitimate movement as quickly as possible especially during inclement or extremely hot weather and longer distances of travelling.
- 6. Valid movement documents and health attestations remains the cornerstone of such movement of animals across the ports of entry or exit.
